Information on Legacy Giving

The Parish of Oxton St Saviour with St Andrew Noctorum welcomes gifts in Wills, however large or small, and we promise to use any gifts to make a difference in our parish. Our Parochial Church Council (PCC) wishes to use these gifts to develop Ministry and Mission within the parish. That may be to fund significant development projects in the parish, whether buildings, equipment or staff.

Since the needs of the parish change over the years, we encourage donors to leave a gift in their Wills for the general purposes of the parish rather than for a restricted purpose. However, a representative of the PCC would be available to discuss the most appropriate use of any gift, in the light of current projects and needs, should the donor want to make a gift for a particular purpose.

As circumstances change over the years, it may not be possible to fulfil specific donor requests. Should this be the case, when the time comes, we will discuss possible uses of the donor's gift with their executors, bearing in mind the donor's known areas of interest in the church (e.g. music, buildings, children and youth, overseas mission or aid) and the church's priorities at the time.
