

CHURCH ANNUAL MEETING and APCM 2020 takes place this Tuesday

Election of Churchwardens, Representatives to the PCC and Deanery Synod

As you will be aware it was not possible to hold these meetings in April due to the lockdown restrictions imposed on account of the national public health emergency from March 2020. The meetings were postponed and will now take place in church (to allow for adequate social distancing measures to be in place) this Tuesday (20th October 2020) at 8.00pm.

At the Annual Meeting of Parishioners on Tuesday 20th October 2020 at **8.00pm**, the election will take place of two Churchwardens. Nominees must be on the Church Electoral Roll or resident in the Parish, must be an actual communicant member of the Church of England and be aged 21 years or over. Each nominee must have a proposer and seconder and give consent to the nomination. Two nominations have already been received namely Mr Andrew Thomson and Mr Tony Parsons.

There will also be elections for the Parochial Church Council (PCC) and Deanery Synod.

For the PCC nominees must have been on the Electoral Roll of the Parish for at least six months, must be an actual communicant and be aged 16 years or over. Each nominee must have a proposer and seconder and give consent to the nomination. The election is for five members of the PCC to serve for three years (until spring 2023) and three members to serve until spring 2021.

For the Deanery Synod nominees must have been on the Electoral Roll of the Parish for at least six months, must be an actual communicant and be aged 18 years over. Each nominee must have a proposer and seconder and give consent to the nomination. The election is for five members of the Deanery Synod to serve for three years (until spring 2023).

Please contact Judith Parry, PCC Secretary if you would like to be nominated or wish to nominate someone for election to either the PCC or Deanery Synod.
